## FontAwesome Icons Read Me

FontAwesome icons are built into the Gravitate Theme and UIKit Framework. Basically you can insert the following code in order to use an icon:

```
<i class="uk-icon-cog uk-icon-large"> </i>
```

**uk-icon-cog** is the name of the icon

**uk-icon-large** is the size; others include -small -medium -x-large

There is a Font Awesome Cheatsheet PDF included with the support files. You will need to highlight code with 'Ignore Formatting' for most pages.

### Navigation Icon [Hamburger Menu]

---

To change icon, copy the following Snippet to the Code / Javascript area in Settings / Javascript for your **site**

```
//changes nav menu icon  
$("#navButton").removeClass('uk-icon-cog uk-icon-small').addClass('uk-icon-bank uk-icon-large');
```

Leave the **.removeClass** code. After **.addClass**, change 'uk-icon-bank' to your chosen icon name.

Example: changing icon to **caret-square-o-left** / **medium size**

```
$("#navButton").removeClass('uk-icon-cog uk-icon-small').  
.addClass('uk-icon-caret-square-o-left uk-icon-medium');
```

The icon color and background color can be changed in RW page settings.

Blog Icon:

**PRO TIP:** Create your own class name like 'my-icon-class' and use CSS to target color, size, etc.

```
$("#navButton").removeClass('uk-icon-cog uk-icon-small').addClass('uk-icon-bank uk-icon-large my-icon-class');
```

CSS:

```
.my-icon-class {  
    font-size: 3em;  
    color: red;  
}
```
